Participation in the competition is open to all young scientists who have earned their last degree within 12 years of October 1st of the year of presentation and are members of the Division of AGFD.

The AGFD board of judges will choose the young scientist who will participate in the symposium.

The awardee will be invited to give an oral presentation, which will be held at the 260th ACS Meeting in San Francisco, CA, August 16-20, 2020.

Therefore, the awardee will receive travel expenses up to \$1000, along with a cash award of \$1000.

Applications are being accepted from young scientists or nominations may be made by colleagues. To be considered, please submit the following items (by e-mail):

1. Application letter or letter of nomination
2. Two letters of recommendation
3. Two page summary of the research of significance
4. *Curriculum vitae* including a list of publications, patents and presentations
5. Abstract of the proposed oral presentation
